If you have advice for other chorus members about their singing, and you are not a Section Leader, then talk to you Section Leader, not to the member concerned because that can be taken amiss.

The same for visual performance – speak to a member of the Visual Team, not the member concerned.

Don't leave it until the last minute to submit your riser - you may not pass the first time & will need to re-submit. Don't make your Section Leader/riser checker chase you.

Before you submit it, listen to it yourself for accuracy of noted, words & breathing plan. If you hear errors, don't hand it in. Work on it and re-record the next rehearsal.

Review your Section Leader's /riser checker's feedback & work on anything she suggests before resubmitting.
