Brisbane 2006 Contest

This year's convention will be held in Brisbane at the Brisbane City Hall. On Friday, 32 quartets will compete with the winner of the competition being eligible to compete at the International Convention later this year in Las Vegas.

19 Choruses will compete on Saturday in the Chorus competition. The winner of the first place overall chorus will be eligible to compete at the International Convention in Calgary, Canada in 2007. Circular Keys Chorus will be competing in both the AA (mid size) category and in the overall chorus category. The winner of the first place AA chorus may also be eligible to compete in the Harmony Classic Competition held as part of the International Education Symposium in San Antonio, Texas in July 2007. To qualify for this, the winner must score points ranking them in the top five of mid-sized choruses IN THE WORLD.

The Convention starts Friday morning, with many of the delegates having flown in the day before. Brisbane city will be abuzz with sequins, big hair and far too much bling. There will be singing in every café, airport lounge, bottle shop (well, that's where the basses will be), hair salon (tenors), internet café (baritones) and we're not entirely sure where the leads will be but we can be sure that they will be noisy!

We have two quartets from Circular Keys Chorus competing this year. First-timers "**Code 4**" are contestant 32 (of 32 contestants!).
