Come along on Sunday 26th September for a wonderful day out with the family at the historic **Rouse Hill House & Farm**, one of the oldest continually occupied homes in Australia!

Founded in 1813 and crammed with 20,000 objects spanning its long life, Rouse Hill House & Farm expresses the hopes and dreams of six generations of family life in rural New South Wales from early colonization to the late 1900s.

You will go on a guided tour to experience the old house with its time-warped rooms, the ancient garden, handsome stables, and the tottering outbuildings, old machinery and rusting vehicles that strew the wider farmstead.

<b>Getting There:</b>	<p>If driving from the city, take the M2, turn right onto Windsor Road, left into Guntawong Road and turn left into the signposted driveway.</p> <p>If driving from Windsor, continue along Windsor Road, pass through a set of traffic lights at Terry Road and turn right into Rouse Road, then right into Worcester Road. Continue past the entry to Rouse Hill Regional Park to the end of Worcester Road, then turn right into Guntawong Road and drive about 200 metres to the signposted driveway.</p> <p>There is free car parking on the grounds outside the Visitors Centre, and a 7 person vehicle available to transport people with walking difficulties from the Visitors Centre to Rouse House.</p>
