## Notice of Special General Meeting

A special general meeting will be held on 25 April 2018.

The purpose of this meeting will be to adopt a new set of Rules for Incorporation for our chorus. The reason for this is that the Regional Management Team has devel-



oped a Region 34 Sweet Adelines Rules for Incorporation document so that every chorus in Australia is able to operate under the same rules.

These rules are very similar to those that our chorus has lodged with our State Incorporation Body. The main difference in these rules is:

it allows for Sweet Adelines choruses in Australia who are incorporated to terminate membership. Sweet Adelines International rules are that a chorus membership can only be terminated by the International Board. Because our incorporation guidelines require the ability for an incorporated association to be able to terminate membership (with an appropriate appeals and grievance process), Sweet Adelines International has agreed that, since this is our law, they will accept that a chorus membership can be terminated by the chorus, as long as notification is given for the reason and the process to International. This does not include Sweet Adelines Membership, it is only in relation to membership within the chorus.

#### Message from Vicki:

Last week we recorded "Come To Australia", "Moment I Thought" and "Make Em Fall". Hopefully, you've had a chance to listen to your tracks and are now working on any corrections you may have identified so you will be in an even better place to record again next week.

Ideally, you want to know if you're assessed as ready for St Louis before the early bird registration prices finish at the start of next month.

Next rehearsal we will make time to record those songs again, as well as time for "Oh Look At Me" and "Change The World".

The music team have now recorded "Come To Australia", "Make Em Fall" and "Change The World" and those recordings are available on the website under each of those songs. You can also record at home and submit your at home recording against music team or against learning tracks as your qualification assessment.

Remember to listen to your recordings before you send them for assessment. Redo your recording if you are hearing problems. When you send your recording,

mention any ongoing difficulties you are having so your section leader knows you are working on these areas and/or can advise some different approaches to help.

If you are not coming to St Louis, we will still want to be able to sing these songs with you. It is important that we are all singing at the same performance level, regardless of whether you'll be competing this time around. We still want to hear you and give you the tick of approval for singing these songs in public performances.

In summary:-

Recordings can be done:-

\* on the risers in rehearsal

\* at home against the music team or learning track (if learning track has a part missing, use the track that is missing your part - otherwise use the 4 part track).
