

- Spending money for food & drinks




The management team have decided it's time to consider a fresh new look for CKC, so we decided to ask you to design a new logo for CKC.

# HAIRDO'S AND DON'TS

Here are some tips on making sure your hair is styled correctly.


- 1. The style is fuller, wide and higher than you would generally wear it.
- 2. There are no hanging tendrils or loose strands that move or cover part of your face.
- 3. Fringes must be styled so your eyes and eyebrows are clearly visible, so your facial expressions can be seen.
- 4. If your hair is shoulder length or longer, pull it back and up away from the face.
- 5. Use unscented hair spray.
- 6. No visible clips, combs, bows or coloured and no sparkly hair spray.



- The idea here is to have no distractions away from the unit look of the chorus, when the camera or judge focuses on you, your face is visible.
- If you will need someone to help with your hair please contact them before you leave, as to what they will be doing for you and where and when to meet you on contest day.
- Allow yourself plenty of time to do your hair.

## APPLYING CKC CHORUS STAGE MAKE UP

- 1. Start with a good moisturiser to seal the skin and allow the foundation to apply smoothly. Apply approximately 20 minutes before putting on foundation.
- 2. FOUNDATION Stroke across forehead, down nose and cheeks and across chin. Blend up to hairline, down towards jaw line using fingers or makeup sponge ensuring even coverage. Apply down your neck also so no water mark is shown.
- 3. LOOSE POWDER Apply translucent loose powder to set your makeup, being careful to shake excess off brush before applying. Apply over where ever foundation is.

#### 4. EYESHADOW

a. HIGHLIGHTER – Start by prepping the eyelids and brow lightly with concealer. This creates a smooth surface on which to apply colour. Apply White shadow all over lid up to eyebrow and down to lash line. Blend well.



- b. EYELID Use Pink colour. With a clean brush apply the pink all over the eyelid and into the crease.
- c. DARK CONTOUR Use Dark Grape colour. With a clean brush in the crease apply the dark colour. Starting from the outside and working in (then you wont have the blob of darker colour on the inside).
- d. Always blend the colour upward and outward until there is no "edge" to the colour.
- e. Apply sparkle dust Opal to the brow bone, just under the eyebrow.
- 5. EYEBROWS Fill in your eyebrows with eyebrow pencil. Apply tiny fine strokes emphasising your natural brow line. All eye makeup should be darker if you wear glasses.
- 6. EYELINER Apply black eyeliner (liquid) to top eyelid. Start very fine at the inner corner and ending thicker at the outer edge THEN in an upward direction on an angle for about ½ cm or a tad more (this gives your eyes a lovely lift). Apply eyeliner (pencil) to outer half of the bottom lids to emphasise your eyes.

#### 7. FALSE EYELASHES

- a. Apply a small amount of eyelash glue to the base of the false eyelashes. Wave around about
- b. 10 seconds until the glue is tacky. Apply the eyelash on the very BASE of your eyelid placing the eyelash slightly off centre towards the outside of the eye.
- c. Touch down ends over your lashes with a brush tip Once in place then seal by holding pressure to the centre first then both ends. THE ENDS ARE MOST IMPORTANT
- 8. MASCARA Mascara top & bottom blending in your top eyelashes with the false.
- 9. BLUSH Red pot colour. Smile to find your cheek bone line and see where to apply the blush.
  - Red Pot use the red sparingly to start with (it's easier to apply a little more if needed than to take off). Start from the outside/top of your cheek bone and dab the red colour on gradually working down at an angle to your cheek. Blend.
- 10. LIPLINER apply red lip liner to outer edges of lips and fill in with pencil.
- 11. LIPSTICK Then apply two coats of approved chorus colour Rimmel "Provocalips" 16 hour 500 Kiss Me You Fool.
- 12. BRONZER Apply bronzing powder over the face, ears and neck.
- 13. HAIR Hair needs to look "done". It should be away from the face and given some "lift" to the crown. You will need a curling brush or hot rollers, mousse, gel and non scented hairspray. Long hair (shoulder length or longer) is to be worn up. Natural wigs and hair pieces are ok. No glitter or sparkle clips, bows, colours, bands etc are to be worn.
