Region 34 Education Team Roles - Positions Vacant

Quartet Education Co-ordinator July 2019 – May 2021

The Quartet Education Co-ordinator (QEC) reports to the Regional Education Co-ordinator (REC)

- The QEC develops, in liaison with the EC, quartet education programs to meet the needs of regional quartets, eg face to face workshops, online webinars etc, and organizes REF to teach at these events.
- Serves as CAL Quartet Liaison that facilitates quality control for CAL quartets.
- Distributes to quartets the judges summary comments from contest.
- Liaises with the Regional Quartet Newsletter editor to develop articles for the Quartet Newsletter.

ATTRIBUTES, SKILLS

This role would suit an experienced quartetter who is passionate about education for quartetters at all levels. They should also possess the following:

- Education / class development skills
- Reliable and organized
- Good at planning
- Good verbal and written communication
- Works well in a team environment
- Diplomatic

SAI Arrangers Certification Program (ACP) – Beginner level in Region Co-ordinator July 2019 – May 2021

The program co-ordinator is responsible to the Regional Education Co-ordinator (REC) for the overall administration of the Beginner Level of the SAI Arranger Certification Program for Region 34 in all areas apart from the actual assessment of exam papers and provision of feedback to participants. The Co-ordinators role includes:

- Provides contact details about each course participant to the Assessor.
- Keeps records of participants in the Beginners ACP program and the skill areas they have achieved.
- Receives requests from participants to undertake exams and sends them sample test papers (provided).
- Sets up exams with the participant, in line with the ACP guidelines.
- Monitors that the Assessor has conducted skill area evaluations & provided timely review of examination results with participants.
- Receives copies of the exam results from the Assessor, sends results to International and maintains accurate records.
- Keeps records of individuals' advancement within the program.
- Providing reports to the Education Co-ordinator each April with an update of the program.
- Maintains confidentiality and administers the program in line with the ACP Guide.
