# Singing for their supper

**T**HE Hills are alive with the sound of music thanks to the Circular keys Chorus.

What started out as a group of singing friends pulled together by Carlingford resident Doris Ward, has blossomed into an acclaimed harmony group.

A year after the friends started singing together, they joined the Sweet Adelines International, a worldwide organisation of women singers committed to advancing the musical style of barbershop harmony.

Now, fifteen years later, the chorus has 82 members ranging in age from 20 to 80 and has just released its second CD *Never Say Never*, recorded during its Wednesday rehearsals at St Josephs Centre in Baulkham Hills.

The 11-strong play list includes some classic songs including Shania Twain's *From This Moment On*, Phil Everly's *When Will I Be Loved* and *You Raise Me Up*.

It also includes the song *It Is Well With My Soul* in memory of member Pauline Davey.

The multi-award winning chorus performed in the US in



October 2009 and was placed 25th in the International Chorus Competition. The CD contains arrangements sung on the tour. Musical director since 2002, Vicki Dwyer said she was pleased with CD and the choice of songs.

"The chorus works together as a team. We meet every Wednesday, sing and then have supper together. It's a lot of fun."

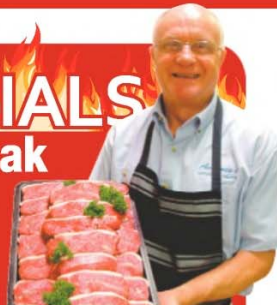
