VIDEO RECORDING PROJECT

Thanks Vicki for creating this fun project. Here is a copy of all the details you need to create and submit your recording to Vicki.

The song is WHAT DOESN'T KILL YOU MAKES YOU STRONGER

Part 1

Record yourself singing your part along to the learning tracks (it doesn't matter if you use the 4 part or your part predominant). Make sure that you are wearing headphones when you make your recording, so it is ONLY your voice on your recording.

TIP – because I will be laying each of the files into a multitrack recording, you will want to be confident enough with the song that there are no little spots where you accidentally slow down (this happens if you are still listening to the music to figure out what the notes are or reading the notes/words). You can use the sheet music but if I can hear you turning pages, I'll need you to re-do it. You'll want to have enough practice runs that you are confident with the words and your notes – I especially want to hear that you have a smile in your voice and not a concerned frown!!

The recording needs to be saved as an mp3. If you are recording on a device that saves as mp4 (iPhone/iPad), be sure to convert your file before sending it. NB there are many conversion apps out there that can do this easily.

Email your mp3 to me for adding to our multitrack (virtual chorus recording).

Part 2

Video of yourself singing along to the tracks. This time, it doesn't matter if the learning tracks can be heard. I would prefer you to be singing as miming tends to look a bit 'affected' and over acted. Think about somewhere that has a nice background and plenty of light. Perhaps outside in your garden etc. I will not be using the sound component of this file but don't try and remove the sound as this will help me to sync the visuals together.

It likely that your file will be too big to be sent via an email however Kath snet her video to Vicki using www.wetransfer.com and that worked really well.



REDUCED CHORUS FEE OPTION FOR 3 MONTHS

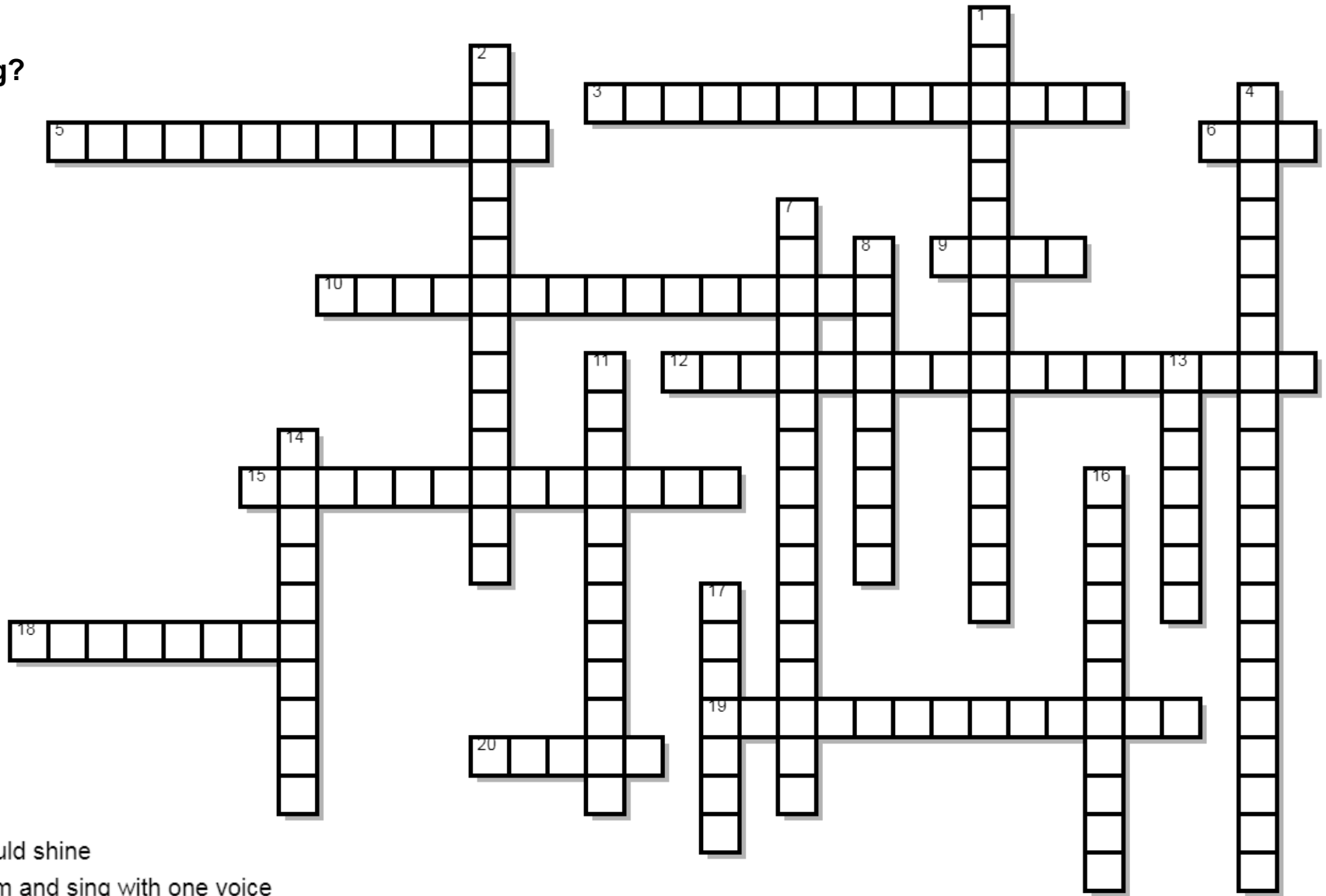
