# **REHEARSAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MARCH 2021**

And we are back...inside in the Pacifica Room.

Please note that the following will apply for rehearsals at St Josephs through March 2021.

Arrival: 6.30pm onwards Departure: 10.30pm – 11.00 pm

As per the current restrictions:

- 1. On arrival at St Josephs, please sign in via the QR scan code and the sign in sheet
- 2. Rehearsals will be in the Pacifica Room and will take place without risers. We will still need to maintain social distancing as per the current COVIDSafe guidelines:
  - No more than 30 performers should sing indoors.
  - All performing singers should face forwards and not towards each other, having physical distance of 1.5m between each other and any other performers, and be 5m from all other people including the audience and director, where practical.
  - In indoor areas, audience members should not participate in singing or chanting.
  - Members of the audience are required to wear face masks when performers are singing
- 3. Receptionist will be on duty until 8.30pm
- 4. Tea/Coffee etc will be in the Pacifica Lounge area
- 5. We will need to turn off the lights in the Pacifica Room and exit via the night doors.



In order to comply with the restrictions, we are implementing a ticket system – 30 tickets will be available to the first 30 people who arrive at rehearsals. The 30 ticket holders will be able to sing, and anyone without a ticket will have to be in the audience, not sing and wear a face mask. Should a ticket holder wish to sit out of part of the rehearsal, they should hand over their ticket to someone in the audience so they can participate in the rehearsal.

The ideal candidate:

- ✓ Serves CKC to the best of her ability without thought of personal gain
- ✓ May hold an elected position or other high profile but is not the previous year's winner, or Doris Ward, or the Music Director.

The candidate displays many or all of the following traits at chorus level:

- Has excellent attendance records at rehearsals, performances, fund raising and other chorus activities
- ✓ Willingly takes on responsibilities and generously donates her skills when required
- ✓ Can be depended upon to carry through tasks/projects to completion
- ✓ Shows keen interest in chorus affairs, respecting and supporting decisions made by chorus Management Team or Music Staff.
- ✓ Believes in the importance of her personal marketing responsibility to present her chorus, the region and Sweet Adelines International in the best positive way to the general public.
