Please Note:

1. On arrival at St Josephs, sign in as usual at the front desk
2. Rehearsals will be in the Chapel and will take place without risers this week.

REGIONAL COMPETITION FILMING

Costume for the contest video:

- Teal sequin top
- Black velvet pants
- New style chorus shoes preferred - though if you are not front row, you can wear alternate black shoes that make sense if you have difficulties that prevent you wearing the chorus shoes
- Black knee high stockings
- Teal sequin earrings
- No watches, bangles, necklaces etc

Make up should be full stage makeup, **excluding** lashes, nail polish and heavy foundation. (we will have a make up demo/guide soon from Kaity and Courtney)

We will also be doing some publicity shots with the photographer and you will need the following costume:

- Black top of your choice
- Black skirt or pants that will go with your top (you may choose to wear the black velvet pants)
- Black shoes of your choice to go with your outfit
- Silver bling earrings and other jewellery as desired

 - Hair and Makeup done
- Publicity Photos
- Change to contest blue tops and velvet pants
- Vocal warmup
- Video
- Quartet videos (3 quartets competing)
