Once these are returned, I can hand out the 2nd place medals.



SURVEY RESULTS


Thanks to everyone who completed the survey regarding the options for CKC in competition. So far 36 members have completed the survey and the results are shown below:


2009 – Nashville (International) – 25th overall

2018 – St Louis (Harmony Classic A division) – 3rd


