What makeup will we put on...

Make up for competition will be the same as last year (for the video competition), however you will need to wear your favourite false eyelashes. The items you will need are:

YOU ARE A CLIMATE CREATOR!

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Each of us can help create the climate or atmosphere each week at rehearsal. We know that we have an effect on those around us energy-wise and interference-wise. We have the capacity to create and maintain our own levels of focus, intention and energy.

How to do that:

- 1. Be intentional about what kind of CLIMATE you want to create each rehearsal. Think about this before you walk in the door.
- 2. Choose a KEY WORD that represents your intention for the evening. (Focused? Committed? Joyful? Generative? Energized? Community? etc) Make that key word one that will positively inspire you and contribute to the chorus atmosphere. Repeat it to yourself throughout the evening, write it on a piece of paper and keep in your pocket to remind you.
- Recognize and celebrate the fact that you do have an impact. Your energy level, your
 level of engagement and your self-talk directly impacts the Chorus climate. Challenge
 yourself to intentionally create the climate that will positively affect the chorus energy and
 unity.

Things to remember on the risers

- Singers voice at all times and best vocal production
 not speaking voice = muscle
- Use CKC Light
- Don't put your instrument on the floor
- Limit Jaw Movement

TIPS TO OVERCOME PERFORMANCE ANXIETY

Most of all - Don't Panic

Use your nerves to your advantage! Remember adrenaline is your friend.

- Be prepared.
- Limit caffeine and sugar intake the day of the performance. Eat a sensible meal a few hours before you are to perform so that you have energy and don't get hungry.
- Shift the focus from yourself and your fear to the enjoyment you are providing to the audience. Close your eyes and imagine the audience cheering, and you feeling good.
- Don't focus on what could go wrong. Instead focus on the positive. Visualize your success.
- Avoid thoughts that produce self-doubt.
- Practice controlled breathing, meditation, biofeedback, and other strategies to help you relax and redirect your thoughts when they turn negative
- Take a walk, jump up and down, shake out your muscles, or do whatever feels right to ease your anxious feelings before the performance.
- Connect with your audience -- smile, make eye contact, and think of them as friends.
- Act natural and be yourself.
- Enjoy the performance



More things to remember on the risers

- Breath early and often take your personal breaths
- Breath deprivation and pitch do not mix
- Each phrase needs to be finished with purpose
- Twitterpation and remember the Dug

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

How you can help run your chorus

Secretary (elected)

- Records minutes of all meetings and files them in a permanent minute book of the Chorus
- Is familiar with and maintains current copies of by laws and standing rules
- Keeps a list of all committees
- Keeps in files copies of all Chorus correspondence
- Conducts all correspondence necessary for the proper functioning of the Chorus and keeps the Management Team and Membership involved
- · Gives notice of meetings as required.

Membership Chair (elected)

- Greets and introduces visitors and potential members to the Director, Team Coordinator and others as appropriate
- Maintains a record of attendance and contacts any member who is not in good standing as per the Standing Rules and advises the Management Team of this
- Maintains and updates First Night Kits, handing them to potential members and filing completed registration forms.
- When a potential member passes her audition, ensures that a membership form is completed and advises the Management Team
- On approval of the member, arranges for her certificate and its presentation
- · Updates singes list as required and distributes it
- Distributes name badges and organizes these for new members
- Makes the Visitors Book available for signing when appropriate

Performance Coordinator (elected)

- Is contact person for all performances
- Obtains Director's approval for performance
- Informs Chorus of details and posts sign-up sheets
- Confirms details with requesting organization
- Is aware of our fee structure and negotiates a suitable fee for performance unless it is a charity performance
- Gives the Director a list of performers and all relevant information
- Maintains a list of performances and contact details
- Passes any fees to the Finance Manager who sends a receipt and thanks them, if appropriate
