 - c. You are not well or have any symptoms, even if you have tested negative for Covid

A perpetual trophy is presented annually, and the recipient of the award is our Sweet Adeline of the Year, recognized at Convention with a certificate.

Nominations are now invited from the chorus. Any current full chorus member is eligible for nomination with the exception of Doris Ward, Vicki Dwyer and the previous year's winners, [Alison Anderson](#) and [Jenny Do Rozario](#)

The ideal candidate:

- ✓ Serves CKC to the best of her ability without thought of personal gain
- ✓ May hold an elected position or other high profile but is not the previous year's winner, or Doris Ward, or the Music Director.

The candidate displays many or all of the following traits at chorus level:

- ✓ Has excellent attendance records at rehearsals, performances, fund raising and other chorus activities
- ✓ Willingly takes on responsibilities and generously donates her skills when required
- ✓ Can be depended upon to carry through tasks/projects to completion
- ✓ Shows keen interest in chorus affairs, respecting and supporting decisions made by chorus Management Team or Music Staff.
- ✓ Believes in the importance of her personal marketing responsibility to present her chorus, the region and Sweet Adelines International in the best positive way to the general public.

ANGEL FUND



Did you know CKC has an Angel Fund to assist Chorus members who may be experiencing personal hardship that prevents them from participating in Chorus activities such as weekend retreats and Convention. Angel Fund assistance cannot be used to pay monthly membership dues.

The Fund is funded from donations and specific fund-raising events. It is administered by the Team Coordinator and Finance Manager and all requests for assistance are confidential.

If you would like to make a donation to the Angel Fund, please deposit it via EFT to the Circular Keys Account and make sure you include **Angel Fund** in the reference field.

There is no requirement to repay assistance, but any members may wish to make a donation to the fund when they are able to do so.

You can contact the Team Coordinator or Finance Manager if you want to ask about assistance. All enquiries will be kept confidential.

CHORUS ETIQUETTE

Honour thy Director -

She knows what she's doing Believe that your Director knows what she's doing and restrain yourself from offering advice on how to run the chorus (or any other topic) while standing on the risers – or any time, really. Wait for her to invite your opinion

Listen, don't correct Often when there's a pause, chorus members try to correct their mistakes or those of their neighbours. Although this may seem important, RESIST. You will miss important comments from the Director that affect everyone in the chorus. Bear in mind that the Director fixes all the problems eventually.



It's important to remember our chorus etiquette. We need to work as a team and respect each other when rehearsing. Look out for the Riser etiquette signs at each rehearsal.

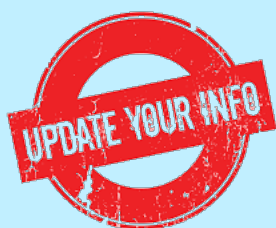
