ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The AGM will be held on Wednesday 22 March 2017

A perpetual trophy is presented annually and the recipient of the award is our Sweet Adeline of the Year, recognised at Convention with a certificate.

Nominations are now invited from the chorus. Any current full chorus member is eligible for nomination with the exception of Doris Ward, Vicki Dwyer and the previous year's winner, Karen Tucker 22 February 2017

CKC BUDGET 2017

Each year the Management Team prepares a budget of income and expenditure so that we can manage our finances more effectively.

Based on our best estimates of income (\$47,070) and expenditure (\$53,060) for 2017, we are expecting a \$5,990 loss in 2017. This is mainly because of falling membership and limited fundraising activities.

While we do have enough funds to cover this deficit, we would prefer to achieve at least a balanced budget. We would like to do this by increasing our income rather than cutting back on expenditure. (Our main discretionary expense is education, i.e. coaching).

We have these options:

- Increase membership by 15 members (15 members x \$420 annual chapter dues = \$6,300)
- Do additional fundraising to raise another \$6000
- Find additional performances (12 performances x \$500 each = \$6,000)
- (least preferred option) Increase chorus dues by \$10 per month to \$60 (50 members x \$10 x 12 months = \$6000)

What we will probably do is a combination of the first three. Note that all of them rely on your participation (recruiting and welcoming new members; helping with fundraising; signing up for performances).
