The Doris Ward Award was instigated in 2006 to recognise the work of CKC's founder and Director for six years, Doris Ward. The purpose of this award is to recognize, honour and thank a special member in our Chorus for her contributions to the chorus. A perpetual trophy is presented annually and the recipient of the award is our Sweet Adeline of the Year, recognised at Convention with a certificate.

Nominations are now invited from the chorus. Any current full chorus member is eligible for nomination with the exception of Doris Ward, Vicki Dwyer and the previous year's winner, Karen Tucker

The ideal candidate:

Serves CKC to the best of her ability without thought of personal gain *May* hold an elected position or other high profile but is not the previous year's winner, or Doris Ward, or the Music Director.

The candidate displays many or all of the following traits at chorus level:

- Has excellent attendance records at rehearsals, performances, fund raising and other chorus activities
- Willingly takes on responsibilities and generously donates her skills when required
- Can be depended upon to carry through tasks/projects to completion
- Shows keen interest in chorus affairs, respecting and supporting decisions made by chorus Management Team or Music Staff
- Believes in the importance of her personal marketing responsibility to present her chorus, the region and Sweet Adelines International in the best positive way to the general public.

Chorus R – Full (+ 3&4 riser from stomp to end) - https://vimeo.com/205736629/c504651186

If you are on the right side, on the 1st/2nd riser, look at "Chorus R – Full (+ 3&4 riser from stomp to end)" up until the stomp. Then watch "Chorus R – partial (1&2 riser from stomp to end)" for the rest, as you will have slightly different timing/moves for the stomp and the last move.

Same applies for if you are on the left side on the 3rd/4th riser or if you are in the centre/bass wedge. Watch the full version of the side you are on, up until the stomp/Bar 48.

TAPING PROGRAM - OH LOOK AT ME NOW

Dear members,

Record your part at home against the "music team" recording.

You are encouraged to USE THE MUSIC so you can follow the lyrics, breath plan, any notation that you need a reminder for.



You are encouraged to SPLIT THE SONG INTO PAGES instead of trying to record a flawless version of the whole thing (unless you happen to be a savant).

We only want your final recordings that you are happy with rather than repeat attempts of the same thing.

You need to listen to your recordings. If you are unhappy with a section of it, rerecord that bit until you are happy and then only send the 'final most happy' version!!

You are encouraged to write your own summary, including what you feel you are doing well and the areas that you know are "a work in progress".

We would like to see how you are tracking with your learning of this song, therefore, we would like your recorded feedback before Linda Keever's coaching weekend (prior to 15/3). Please understand that in order to help you learn efficiently, it is better to check in with your progress rather than wait until later when mistakes may have been cemented into place.
